Checks should be made payable to CPI and will only be deposited upon acceptance to the May Fair. You will be notified by post card of your acceptance. Those applications not accepted will have their check returned to them with notification of the committee's decision.

Fees for those accepted to participate are non-refundable.

Notification of location and arrival instructions will be sent to you in May.

Note: Anyone accepted during the late registration period (if spaces are available) will be notified as quickly as possible.

ARRIVAL & SETUP: Participants must arrive between 6:30 and 7:30 am. Haddon Avenue will be closed to automobile traffic at 7:45 am and no cars will be allowed on the Avenue for unloading after this time. It is very important that you arrive on time to ensure a smooth and timely set-up for everyone.

PARKING: A parking pass will be sent to you with your arrival instructions and location information. After unloading you will be directed to nearby parking.

DISPLAY SPACE: Each participant will be allotted a 10'x10' space. You are responsible for providing your own table(s), chairs, backdrop, etc. Tents are welcome and recommended. ***Electric is not provided.*** If you have a special need, please note it on the form and we will contact you and try to accommodate your request. If it is not noted on the form, we cannot assist you.
