RESOLUTION 06- 184

**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
BOROUGH OF COLLINGSWOOD AND THE EDUCATION
INSTITUTE OF ROWAN UNIVERSITY**

WHEREAS, Collingswood is the recipient of a grant from the State of New Jersey Department of Education in the amount of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) (“Grant”) to be used to conduct Studies for 1.) registration and residency coordination, and 2.) curriculum coordination for the Collingswood, Oaklyn and Woodlynne School Districts (“Studies”); and

WHEREAS, the Education Institute of Rowan University (“Rowan”) has submitted a proposal to the Collingswood School District dated August 24, 2006 for the purpose of conducting the Studies for the three (3) school districts (“Proposal”), which has been reviewed by the school boards for the three school districts as well as the governing bodies of the three municipalities; and


WHEREAS, the three municipalities and the three school districts agree that the Studies as proposed by Rowan will assist the school districts with curriculum development, the selection of textbooks and other educational materials and the development of criteria for and implementation of remedial education plans; and


WHEREAS, the municipalities and the school districts agree that Collingswood may enter into an agreement with Rowan to conduct the Studies described in the Proposal and that it shall be responsible for payment for such services; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Borough of Collingswood consider it to be in the best interest of the residents of the Borough of Collingswood to enter into the agreement with the Education Institute of Rowan University for the purposes stated herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by Commissioners of the Borough of Collingswood, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that the Mayor of the Borough of Collingswood or his designee shall be authorized to execute an agreement with the Education Institute of Rowan University for the purposes stated herein.
