SUBJECT: DESIGNATING BUS STOPS ALONG THE WHITE HORSE PIKE


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Commissioners of the Borough of Collingswood, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that pursuant to NJSA 39:4-8(e) the following described locations are designated as bus stops:




1. Along the White Horse Pike (CR606), Westbound, on the Northerly Side thereof at: a. Between Park Avenue and Ferry Avenue, Mid-block, beginning 120 feet West of the westerly curbline of Park Avenue and extending 135 feet westerly therefrom. (500 feet west of the Collingswood Diner)
2. Along the White Horse Pike (CR606), Eastbound, on the southerly side thereof at: a. Between Park Avenue and Ferry Avenue, Mid-block, beginning 110 feet West of the prolongation of the westerly curbline of Park Avenue and extending 135 westerly therefrom. (In front of Aldi's Supermarket)

That the Mayor and Commissioners of the Borough of Collingswood will enforce the needed traffic regulations governing the aforementioned bus stops location and provide the necessary police security to ensure the safety of the traveling public.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect upon approval of the New Jersey Commissioner of Transportation as provided by law.
