Dear Mayor Fuentes:

This letter follows mine and Mayor Maley's telephone conversation with you earlier today regarding the Interlocal Service Agreement for law enforcement services ("Agreement") between the Borough of Collingswood ("Collingswood") and the Borough of Woodlynne ("Woodlynne"). As we discussed, Woodlynne has failed to pay the sum of \$168,593.75 which was due on March 1, 2010. Accordingly, Woodlynne is in default of the Agreement.

During the course of our telephone conversation you stated that payment would not be forthcoming. In addition, you stated that you would not be able to meet today with me and Mayor Maley. Therefore, due to Woodlynne's refusal to comply with the terms of the Agreement, please be advised that Collingswood has no choice but to terminate all law enforcement services as of March 31, 2010. Collingswood does not have the available resources to provide these services without compensation and it is unreasonable for Woodlynne to expect it to do so.

Please be further advised that it is Collingswood's intention to enforce all remedies available to it including a claim for payment for services rendered through the above date.
