

ORDINANCE NO. 1421

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A JOINT MUNICIPAL COURT BETWEEN THE
BOROUGH OF COLLINGSWOOD AND WOODLYNNE**

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1 et seq., two or more municipalities, by ordinance, may enter into an agreement establishing a joint municipal court and providing for its administration; and


WHEREAS, the New Jersey Interlocal Services Act, N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 et seq., provides that a municipality may enter into a contract with another municipality for the joint provision within their jurisdictions of a joint municipal court; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Borough of Collingswood consider it to be in the best interest of the citizens of the Borough of Collingswood to enter into the interlocal services agreement with the Borough of Woodlynne to establish a joint municipal court for the Boroughs;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the Borough of Collingswood, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that the Borough of Collingswood shall be authorized to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the Borough of Woodlynne to establish a single joint municipal court to be known as "The Municipal Court of the Borough of Collingswood " and to provide for its administration.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication according to law.


