

ORDINANCE NO. 1426

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT AND NAMING OF POWELL LANE AND THE EXTENSION OF NORTH ATLANTIC AVENUE IN THE BOROUGH OF COLLINGSWOOD

I. PURPOSE

The Borough Commissioners, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-1, have the authority to establish a public street, lane or alley within the Borough and have determined that such action is appropriate for the new street created within the Lumberyard Redevelopment Project and the extension of an existing street ("North Atlantic Avenue") which are depicted on the subdivision plan prepared for the project by Remington & Vernick Engineers and as approved by the Borough of Collingswood Planning Board.

II. ENACTMENT




The Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Collingswood in the County of Camden, and State of New Jersey does ordain and enact the following Ordinance:

The new street and the extension of an existing street ("North Atlantic Avenue") which are depicted on the subdivision plan prepared by Remington & Vernick Engineers and as approved by the Borough of Collingswood Planning Board for the Lumberyard Redevelopment Project shall be named and hereafter be known as "Powell Lane" and the other shall continue to be known as "North Atlantic Avenue".

III. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval, and publication, as provided by law.
