

## APPLICATION FOR A MARRIAGE LICENSE

### Where to Apply

1. If the female applicant is a resident of New Jersey, the application is to be made in the municipality she resides.
2. If the female is not a resident of New Jersey but the male is, the application is to be made in the municipality where he resides.
3. If neither applicant resides in New Jersey, application should be made in the town where the marriage will take place.
4. A witness at least eighteen (18) years old must appear with the applicants and swear to completeness and accuracy of the answers supplied by the applicants.

### Registrar Requests

1. The registrar will request proof of residency from the applicants such as driver's license, lease, tax return, utility bill, etc.
2. If applicants are 18 years old or younger a birth certificate is required.
3. If previously married a copy of the death certificate or final divorce decree, whichever may apply must be presented.

### Waiting Period & Expiration

A minimum period of at least seventy-two (72) hours, or 3 working days is required between the time of the application and the time of issuance of the marriage license. The marriage license will expire 30 days after the issuance date.
