RESOLUTION 07- 117

SUBJECT: AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR FIREWORKS DISPLAY AS AN
EXTRAORDINARY UNSPECIFIED SERVICE TO INTERNATIONAL FIREWORKS MFG.
COMPANY

Whereas, the Borough Commission has determined that there exists a need for the provision of a special imaginative and artistic program of fireworks and music in connection with Collingswood's Fourth of July celebration; and

WHEREAS, the combination of music and fireworks requires an artistic sense of timing and taste in order to produce a satisfying and pleasurable program; and

WHEREAS, the use of explosives is highly regulated and dangerous and requires extensive expertise, training, and proven reputation as attributes of the contractor delivering the fireworks display; and

WHEREAS, such an artistic and aesthetic endeavor cannot be reasonable described by written specifications; and

WHEREAS, the funds are available for payment of such extraordinary services and materials; and

Whereas, N.J.S.A. 40A:1-1 et seq. allows the awarding of a contract for extraordinary unspecified services without competitive bids, and


WHEREAS, the C.F.O. and the Borough Attorney have certified that the proposed contract complies with N.J.S.A. 40:11-1 et seq. And with the regulations governing the award of an extraordinary unspecified services contract,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Commission of the Borough of Collingswood, County of Camden, that the Borough Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract with International Fireworks Mfg. Company, in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract is awarded without competitive bid as an extraordinary unspecified service in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40a:11-5(A) (II) of the Local Public Contracts Law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11(a) (ii), a notice of the awarding of the contract be printed once in a newspaper authorized by law to publish legal advertisements and that a copy of the resolution and contract be made available in the Borough Clerk's office for public inspection.
